Its amazing being on that broad. You can see everything, birds, boats, everything.

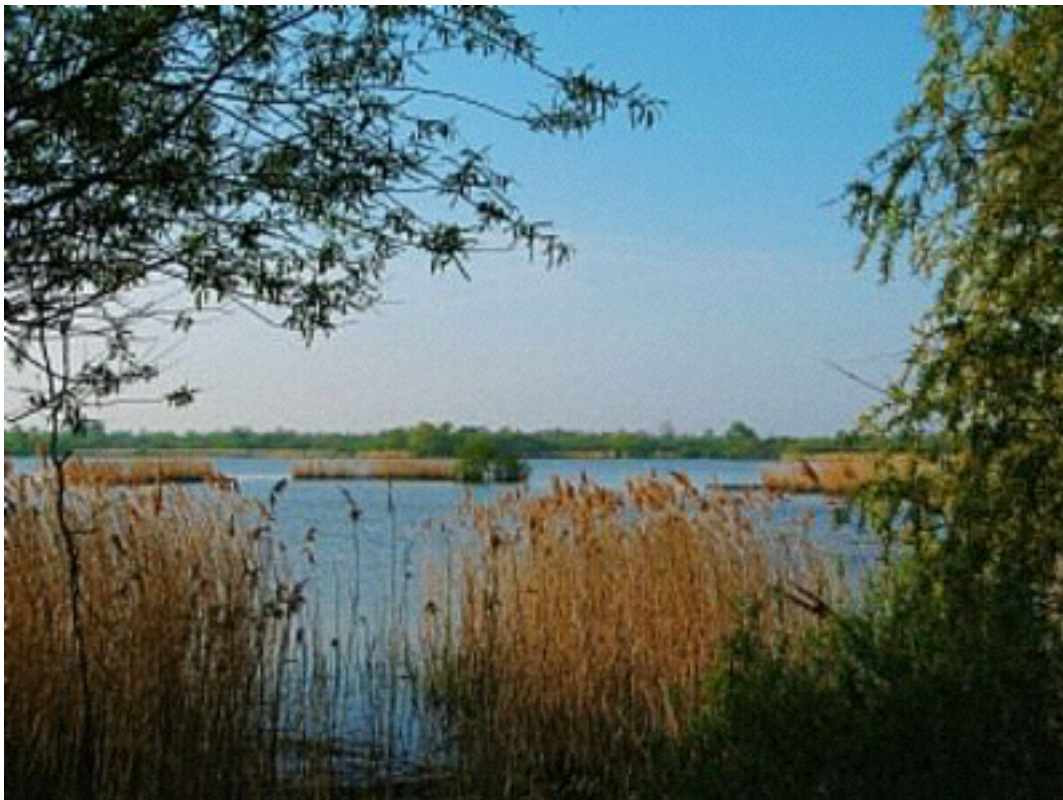
I saw 2 swans and lots and lots of gulls, (and boats).
