I went on the marsh with my dad this evening. It was nice and sunny, but the marsh was all damp from the rain.

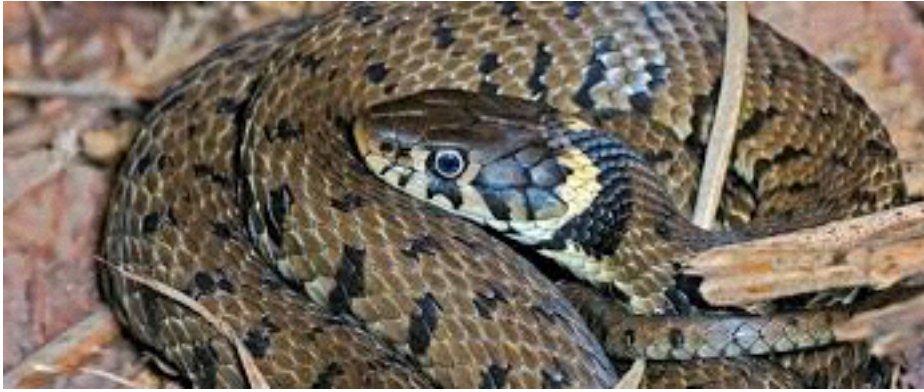


Before we sat down, we looked under the tin to see if anything was there like we always do. This time we were really lucky!
