



30 Days Wild By Eddie Barnes

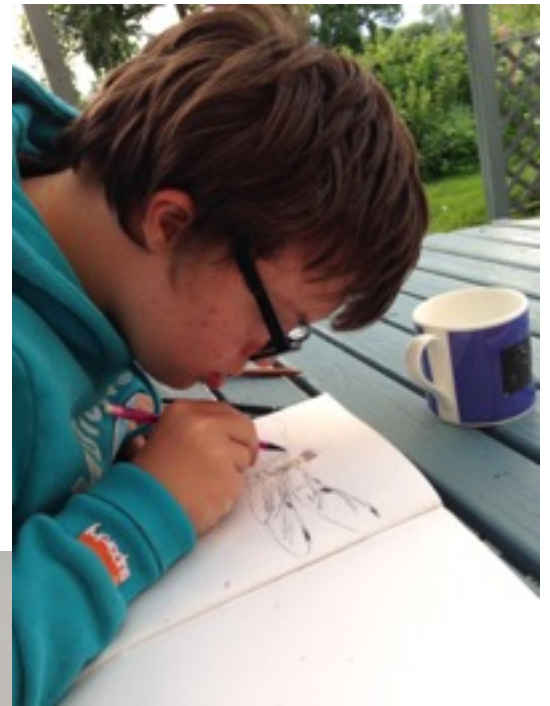


We sat by our pond yesterday and it was amazing how many flowers there are! We saw a great big dragonfly.
